Myron Wallace Kinzler was born June 18, 1934 in Keokuk County, son of Wallace and Coila Roine (Ridenour) Kinzler. He graduated from Millersburg High School in 1952. Myron served in the United States Army during the Korean War from 1953-1955. Myron was united in marriage to Marlys Marie Cable on Sept. 18, 1955, at the Fundamental Gospel Church in Williamsburg. Following their marriage, the couple made their home in rural Williamsburg. He worked for Les Oliver from 1955 to 1979, when they moved to Paw Paw, IL, where he farmed until 1999. They then returned to Iowa County in retirement. He was past president of the Co-op in Paw Paw and a member of the Iburg Poulson VFW Post 8797 in Williamsburg. Myron passed away Saturday, Nov. 2, 2024, at Highland Ridge Care Center in Williamsburg.

He is survived by his two daughters, Lori (Dr. Steve) Meress of Fond du Lac, WI, and Marcy (Robert) Noble of Colfax; a granddaughter, Kylie Good (Andrew Madsen); two great-granddaughters, Natalie and Mickenna Good; and a sister-in-law, Phyllis Kinzler of North English.
