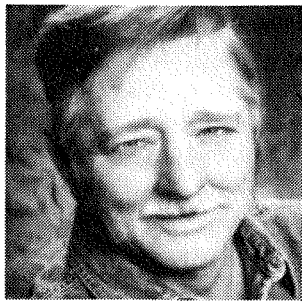


Doug Francis Lavent
