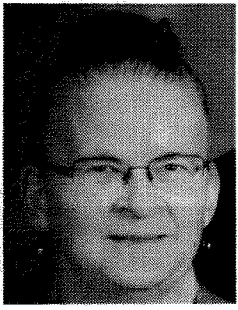


Mary Ellen Storm
