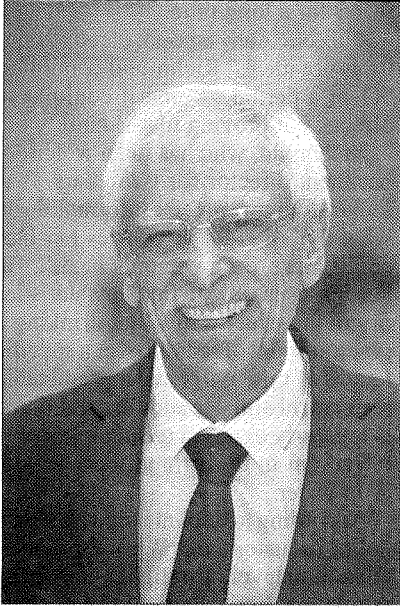


## Virgil Eugene Arment

Virgil enjoyed camping, cross-country skiing, reading, listening to Jimmy Buffett, and cheering on the Denver Broncos. He was always equipped with the tools to fix almost everything; he prided himself on always being prepared and lending a helping hand. He cared deeply about his work and took great pride in the fact that he always brought every member of his crew home safely. He loved and was loved deeply by his family.

He is survived by his wife, Lori; his children, Alex Page, Jacob Arment, and Toby Arment; and his siblings, Dennis Arment of Ankeny, and Linda (Gary) Hunter of Fairlawn, Ohio; and numerous other relations.
