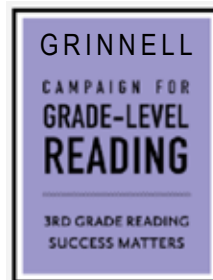




The **Grinnell AmeriCorps Partnership** brings together community non-profits, area employers, the Grinnell-Newburg School District, and community volunteers to support kids and families in Grinnell. By working together in new ways, the Partnership aims to:

- Give students a strong start so they can succeed in school in the early years
- Help students with a strong finish so they are prepared to do well after graduation

The community's interest in working together with the national **Campaign for Grade-Level Reading** began with a school district introduction to the Campaign in the spring of 2013-14. The enthusiasm grew rapidly with a unanimous decision by 20+ community organizations to apply to join the Campaign. A 2015 AmeriCorps grant transformed the effort by funding a team of AmeriCorps Members to support both the Campaign for Grade-Level Reading for young students as well as a "Skills Gap" initiative at the high school level.
