# **Programming**

Under an American Library Association (ALA) grant, four GHS students took part in the News Literacy Project, learning how to become smarter consumers of news and information. The students gave an awesome public presentation!

Our youth continue to choose DCL as an afterschool destination. Programming includes DASH (Drake After School Happenings), Lego Club and a story time with the STARS Galaxy group.

Aldo Leopold enthusiasts from the community collaborated with the library to produce a series of well-attended programs in the spring.

An ILEAD (Iowa Libraries Explore, Apply, and Discover) grant launched the Poweshiek History Preservation Project. PHPP is a collaborative effort with Grinnell College Libraries, enabling individuals to digitize their historical documents, resulting in a digital archive of life in this area.

The largest program attendance occurred during the annual Summer Library Program, with 230 patrons learning about reptiles with "Snakes Alive".

Registered SLP participants read a total of 4,084 hours and turned in 640 reading logs/cards!



# 2013 Highlights

# **Facility Improvement**

An engineering study of the HVAC system was conducted in Sep '12. This resulted in recommendations for improvements to the humidity control and energy recovery ventilation systems. FY14 funds have been allocated to perform improvements.

#### **New Online Resources**

Thanks to funding from the Friends of DCL, the library now offers access to Ancestry Library Edition and Heritage Quest genealogy resources.

Freegal, a downloadable music service, was added to our online offerings this year. Freegal allows library cardholders to permanently download three songs per week from a catalog of nearly three million songs.

#### **Archival Services**

The physical archive was accessed 180 times during the year. Two large historical collections were received from GRMC and the Jaycees, a former Grinnell organization. Great care is taken to assure records are preserved for current and future generations.




