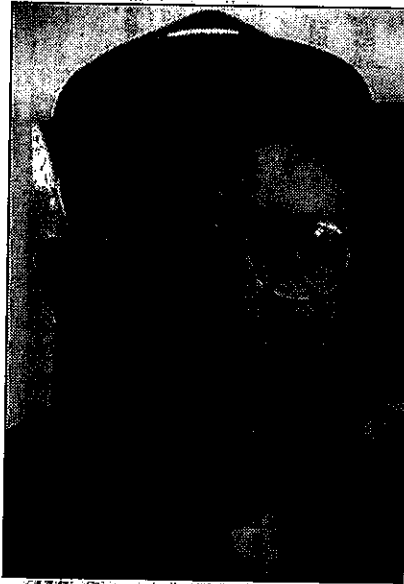


Thomas A. Good 611-R
