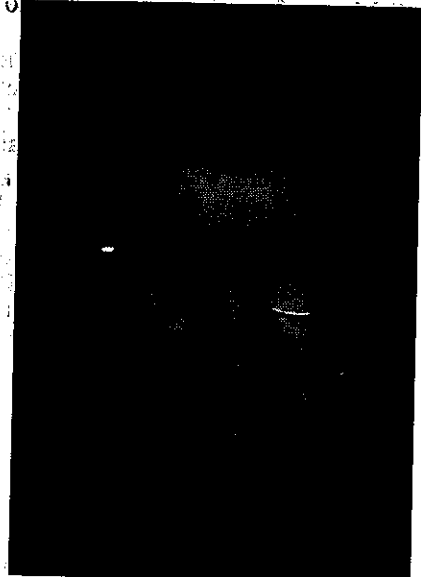


Doris M. Hohl

She was raised in Grinnell and graduated from Grinnell High School with the class of 1938. She attended American Institute of Business College in Des Moines and later worked for Allied Insurance in Des Moines.

She was united in marriage to Melvin LaVerne Hohl on March 30, 1952, at the Malcom United Methodist Church in Malcom, Iowa. The couple purchased a farm northeast of Malcom in 1954 where they had lived all of their married lives. Doris worked at several local businesses including Graham's Department Store, Grinnell General Hospital, Brammer's Pharmacy, Stadium's Unlimited, and General Telephone Company.
