Richard Eugéné "Dick" Hasley 64, of Los Banos, Calif. and Peterson, Iowa died Sept. 21, at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake. Services were Sept. 28, at the Holland-Coble Funeral Home in Montezuma.

Dick was born June 17, 1947 in New Sharon, the son of Lewis and Arlene Bunnell Hasley and grew up in Searsboro and Brooklyn, most recently residing in Peterson, and Los Banos, Cali. He was graduated from BGM High School in 1965 and graduated from the University of Iowa with a Bachelor's Degree in business. Richard truly valued the time he spent with friends and family.
