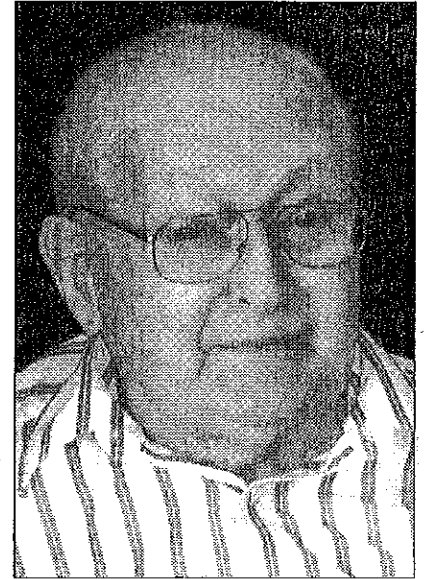


## Lloyd E. Sparks
