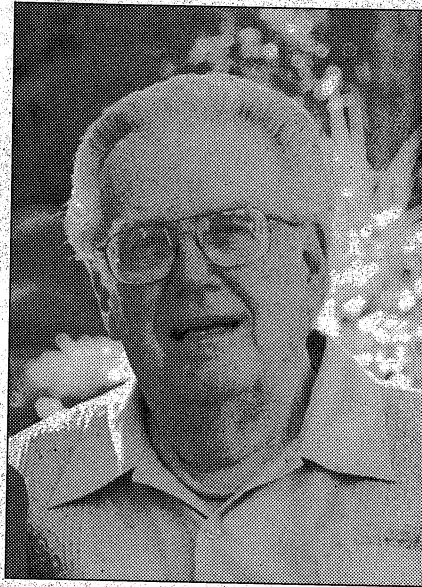
Glen Bell, 95, of Grinnell, died Friday, June 14, 2024, at his home under the care of UnityPoint Hospice.
