### ***Harry Niemants Passes Away After A Brief Illness***

Friends in Grinnell and surrounding community were saddened Tuesday evening when they learned of the death of Harry Niemants at a local hospital. Harry had been employed until recently at the Morrison-Shults Mfg. Company and was considered a fine workman and was well liked by his employers and co-workers. He resigned a short time ago to accept a position at the tri-cities.

Harry was the son of Jacob and Nellie Niemants who live southwest of Grinnell and was born June 13, 1913 at Killduff, Iowa, making him a little more than twenty-three years of age at the time of his death.
