Kenneth Coble, 84, of Keswick, died Friday, Sept. 6, 2024 at the Parkview Manor in Wellman. Funeral services were Wednesday, Sept. 11, at the Holland-Coble Funeral Home in What Cheer. Kenneth Ronald Coble was born in Hayesville on Feb. 9, 1940, the son of Kenneth William and Marion Ruth Jacobs Coble. Ron attended school through the ninth grade.
