## Hold Rites For Area Farmer, Roy Pohlman, 61

Funeral services were held at Tama Tuesday for Roy Pohlman, 61, Grinnell, who died at a local hospital Dec. 24th following an illness of several weeks.

Officiating at the services was the Rev. C. E. Kingsley, pastor of the First Baptist church, and music was by Mrs. Cecil Bearden and Mrs. Dorothy Strine. Floral attendants were Mrs. Fank Turner and Mrs. Norval Simmons.

Pallbearers were Frank Turner, Elza Heishman, Earl Heishman, Frank Fontinel, Lavern Lamb and Lester Mahlin. Interment was in Sheridan cemetery.

On Oct. 14th, 1927, he was united in marriage with Frances Irene Bakke at Clinton. Most of their married life was spent on the farm and they lived in Poweshiek county, in the Sheridan community, for about 30 years.
