Rites held for Harley Pollock

Harley Lewis Pollock, 54 of Bridgeport, Neb., died Tuesday, May 14, at the Morrill County Community Hospital in Bridgeport.

Graveside services were conducted Saturday, May 18, at the Powersville, Mo., Cemetery, with the Christensen Funeral Home of Bridgeport in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Pollock was born May 16, 1930, at Sewal, Iowa, where he was raised and educated. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict. After his discharge, he was married to Pauline Barritt on
