was born March 18, 1886 near Hedrick, Iowa and died at an Oskaloosa hospital June 20, following a short illness.

The daughter of James Harvey Stansberry and Rebecca Jane Burtlow Stansberry, she was married at Omaha, Nebraska on October 6, 1909, to William Guilford Pomeroy. Three sons were born to this union, William of Binghamton, New York, Albert, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and Clyde of Temple City, California. The couple resided in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania for many years but following the death of her husband, Mrs. Pomeroy finally located in Searsboro. Here she followed her profession as a trained nurse.
