Lloyd James Poole, 67, of Oskaloosa, died Monday, June 5, 1989, at the V.A. Medical Center in Iowa City. He was born Dec. 8, 1921, in Deep River, the son of Frank Poole and Pansy Nelson Poole, and was raised by Charles and Nellie Ferneau, now deceased.

Poole served in the Central European Theater in World War II and won five Bronze Stars. He married Evelyn Hopwood Oct. 7, 1966, in Oskaloosa. He was a licensed practical nurse from 1967 to 1982.

He is survived by his wife, Evelyn, of Oskaloosa; one son, Michael Poole of Kellogg; one step-son, Michael Perry of Omaha, Neb.; two daughters, Denise Beadle of Altoona and Kim Perry of Oskaloosa; five grandchildren; one brother, Cloyd Poole of Millington, Ill.; and sister, Irene Benson of Aurora, Ill.

He was preceded in death by one son, Lloyd E. Poole.
