

POST, Mr. and Mrs. H. G. Post of Wilton Junction, Ia., who visited Grinnell in Oct. 1900. Came to Grinnell in 1860 on the old "Concord" coach from Iowa City, then the terminus of the railroad. Mr. Post in company with D. L. Cushing was the contractor who graded the ten miles of R. I. track just east of Grinnell. Mr. and Mrs. Post sang with Mr. Beaton, Rev. Mr. Rickerson and others in the Fourth of July celebration held in 1860 in the incompleted college building. J. E. Grinnell delivered the oration on that occasion.
