Newton Rites For Willard Powell, 37, Kellogg Resident

Funeral services for Willard C. Powell, 37, of Kellogg, who died Monday at a Grinnell hospital, were held Wednesday afternoon at Newton. Burial was in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.

Powell, a former Grinnell resident, was a trucker and livestock-buyer at Kellogg. He had suffered a heart attack.

Born at Grinnell on Apr. 19th, 1927, he was the son of John and Osha Crocket Powell. He attended Grinnell schools and had lived in Kellogg for the past 20 years.
