Michael Price services held

Funeral services for Michael Price, 29, of 1625 Third Ave., Grinnell, who died of hypothermia inside a cave he was exploring with a Grinnell College expedition Saturday near Luana in northeast Iowa, were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Brooklyn.

The Rev. Fr. Karl Holtkamp celebrated the Funeral Mass. Organist was Marilyn Kriegel, and vocalist was Sybil Kelley. Pallbearers were Mark Fitzgerald, Phil Woodall, Don Wauters, Richard May, Bill Plants and Bill Kelley. Burial was in Calvary Cemetery, Brooklyn.

A Rosary service was conducted at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn. Earlier, a memorial service was conducted in Herrick Chapel on the Grinnell College campus, with the Rev. Fr. Harry Linnenbrink, pastor of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Grinnell, officiating.

The son of Robert B. and Betty Marion Wauters Price, he was born on June 22, 1957, in Grinnell. He received his education in the Brooklyn-Guernsey-Malcom schools of Brooklyn where he participated in football and wrestling. He graduated from

BGM High School in 1976, then attended Des Moines Community College for two years and Hawkeye Technical Institute of Waterloo for two years. He worked for Gladolf of Wheeling, Ill., then returned to Grinnell 1/2 years ago to work as a technician in the college's Computer Services.

Mr. Price was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church here.

He is survived by his mother; one brother, Bob of Des Moines; two sisters, Linda of Kirksville, Mo., and Christy of Grinnell; and his grandmother, Naomi Price of Brooklyn.

He was preceded in death by his father, his paternal grandfather and his maternal grandparents.
