Floyd W. Puls, 67, of 1624 Fifth Ave., Grinnell, died early Wednesday morning at Mercy Hospital in Des Moines.

Funeral services for Mr. Puls will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home, with the Rev. Marcus Reitz, pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of Fred and Emma Hink Puls, he was born in Grant Township southeast of Grinnell on Aug. 7, 1910. He attended schools in Chester Township.
