Last Rites Said For Hilda Puls

Hilda Puls, 55, wife of Louis Puls of Rte. 1, Malcom, died early Thursday morning at Grinnell General hospital following an extended illness.

The daughter of Fred and Katharine Hink Jantzen, Mrs. Puls was born on Jan. 17, 1915 in Chester Township and received her education in the rural schools of that community.

On March 2, 1949, she was united in marriage to Louis Puls at the Lutheran Church in Tama, Iowa. Since their marriage they have lived and farmed six miles east of Grinnell.

Survivors include her husband, Louis; her son, Melvin; three sisters—Mrs. Jerome (Minnie) Parmely of Grinnell and Mrs. Milvoy (Stella) Silhanek and Mrs. Edward (Edna) Hayek both of Chelsea, Iowa; two brothers—Leonard Jantzen of Tama and Clifford Jantzen of Grinnell, and several nieces and nephews.
